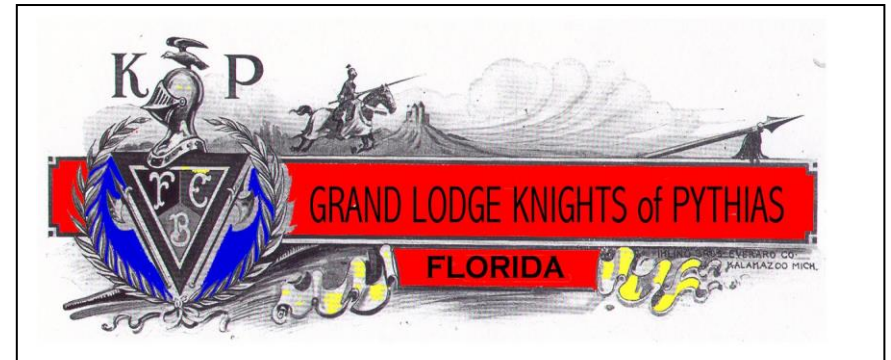

Welcome to the 130th Annual Grand Lodge Session, to be held in Tallahassee, Florida, May 24-25, 2019.

LODGING:

The Grand Lodge Convention will be held at the Homewood Suites, 2987 Apalachee Parkway; Tallahassee, Fl. 32301 (850-402-9400). Guaranteed room rate (Either Two Double Beds or One King. All rooms are suites.) - \$120.00 plus 12.5% tax. All reservations will need to be made by Friday, April 12, 2019 in order to guarantee the group rate. Also reservations can be made online at www.tallahassee.homewoodsuite.com Knights of Pythias: code KOP. **From Interstate-10** - Exit 209A onto Mahan Drive, West-90 West. Go straight two miles and turn left onto Capitol Circle 319 South. Go one mile and turn right onto Apalachee Pkwy US 27. Hotel is on the left. **From US Hwy. 27W** - Cross Capitol Circle. Hotel is on the left. **From Tallahassee Regional Airport** - Turn right onto Capitol Circle. Go 10 miles and turn left on Apalachee Pkwy US 27. Hotel is on the left.
